Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.

None appears for the respondents.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent authorities have constructed a road by encroaching upon the homestead land of the petitioner, but the said land has neither been acquired, nor any compensation paid to the petitioner. The petitioner submitted a representation in this regard before the concerned authority on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 which is yet to be considered. The petitioner prays for a direction upon the authority to consider the representation at the earliest.

Upon consideration of the submission made on behalf of the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of directing the 8<sup>th</sup> respondent to consider and dispose of the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 within two months from the date of communication of this order upon affording reasonable opportunity of hearing to all the interested persons including the petitioner, in accordance with law.

The decision taken by the authority shall be communicated to the petitioner within a week thereof.

Since the respondents are not represented a copy of this order be furnished to the 8<sup>th</sup> respondent by the petitioner at the earliest.

The writ petition is thus disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit has been invited, allegations contained in the writ petition shall be deemed not to have been admitted.

Urgent certified website copy of the order, if applied for, be given to the parties on compliance of requisite formalities.
