None appears on behalf of either of the parties. This matter is pending in the list since 23.02.2023 and has been called on each day of working of this Court since that date. In spite of that no one is appearing. The petitioner is found to be not interest in this case. Therefore, the same is taken up today for disposal on merit.

The petitioner is to seek for quashing of the FIR being Sonarpur police station case no. 718 of 2016 dated 30.03.2016 under Sections 498A/406/354B/325/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

According to the petitioner, FIR would not reveal any cognizable offence against him and thus the proceedings against him in this case would be an abuse of thd process of Court.

On perusal of the entire materials available on record and the grounds made up by the petitioner I am constrained to find that the grounds thereof are not sufficient and cogent enough to warrant this Court's interference into the impugned order. Hence, in my considered opinion the revision is liable to be dismissed.

Criminal Revision being CRR 2077 of 2016 is dismissed.
