It is submitted on behalf the petitioners that they have been falsely implicated in the case.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

We have considered materials on record including the injury report. Both the injuries have been described as 'slight'.

Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petitioners shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM (A) 2549 of 2023 is disposed of.
