None appears on behalf of the opposite parties.

This revisional application is preferred challenging the impugned Order dated 15th May, 2015 whereby learned Trial Court allowed the application filed by the petitioner under Order-9 Rule 13 C.P.C alongwith an application filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act.

Being aggrieved by and dissatisfied with the impugned order passed by the learned Trial Court, the petitioner has preferred this present revisional application which is pending since the year 2015.
