Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.

We have considered the materials on record including the injury report. Whether the injuries are life threatening may be assessed during trial. Petitioner is in custody for 83 days. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner for progress of investigation is not necessary. There is no chance of abscondence.

Hence, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petitioner, viz., Anar Sk shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Krishnagar, Nadia subject to condition that he shall appear

before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
