1. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.
2. The injury report in respect of the victim shows that he had sustained a fracture injury on shaft of the left humerus. In view of such, offence Section 307 IPC is not attracted at least prima facie.
3. Regard being had to such facts and submissions, factum of permanent residence of the petitioners, nature of offence, nature of injury as discussed supra and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that each of the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Arresting Officer in the event of their arrest in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case including the conditions (i) the petitioners are

directed to appear before the IO once in a week on the day and time fixed by the IO for the purpose of investigation till submission of Final Form and (ii) the petitioners shall not threaten, induce or coerce any witness of this case in any manner whatsoever during the currency of this order.

4. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
5. The application being CRM(A) 2614 of 2023 is disposed of.
6. The Arresting Officer is hereby directed to act upon the server copy of this order.
