The present revisional application has been preferred for expeditious disposal of N.D.P.S Case No. 61 of 2020, which arose out of Belghoria P. S. Case No. 416 of 2020 dated 04.09.2020.

The stage at which the petitioner approached this court on the said date the petitioner was detained in custody. The case of the year 2020. In case, the petitioner is in custody, the learned trial court would fix at least a schedule of four dates and fix a schedule once in a month so that the trial of the case can be taken to its logical conclusion within a reasonable period of time.

No unnecessary adjournments should be granted to either of the parties. If required, the learned trial court in respect of absence of witnesses belonging to Government Department would communicate with the Superintendent of Police of the District or the Commissioner of Police who is in charge of police station conducting the investigation to ensure regarding the presence of such witnesses on the dates so fixed by the learned trial court. The Public Prosecutor appearing in the case would produce the materials, documents and exhibits on the dates fixed for

examination of the witnesses concerned. All efforts be taken by the stake-holders to complete the trial at the earliest.

With the aforesaid observations, the present revisional application being CRR 2484 of 2022 is disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, are consequently disposed of.

All concerned parties are to act in terms of a copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this court.
