It appears from the prayers of the petitioner that she wants weightage and/or equivalent marks for obtaining teacher training certificate from State recognized institutions instead of N. C. T. E. approved institutions and for appointment as primary teachers. The policy of the State and also the law is that a candidate must obtain qualification of training from an institute recognized by N. C. T. E.

I completely fail to understand how such a peculiar prayer can be made before this court against a law. No Mandamus can be issued against a law.

Therefore, I direct the petitioner to pay a cost of Rs.5,000/- to be paid to the High Court Legal Services Committee within a period of ten days from date. If the cost is not paid, steps will be taken up for recovering the cost in accordance with law.
