1. The report as submitted on behalf of the State, be taken on record.
2. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
3. The investigation is stated to have progressed substantially.
4. Regard being had to the facts and submission, factum of permanent residence of the petitioners, nature of allegation, quantum of punishment for the offence alleged which is basically an offence under Section 3(a) of the RP(UP) Act, further fact that the petitioner can be held to be receiver of the property of dacoity and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that each of the petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of their arrest by the Arresting Officer in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case including the conditions that:

- i) the petitioners are directed to appear before the

I.O. once in a week on the day and time fixed by the I.O. for the purpose of investigation till submission of F.F.

- ii) the petitioners shall not leave the jurisdiction of the P.S. without obtaining prior leave from the I.O.

5. The petitioners are directed to appear before the I.O. within 21 days from today along with a server copy or certified copy of this order.
6. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
7. The application being **CRM (A) 3014 of 2023** is disposed of.
8. The I.O. is hereby directed to act upon the server copy of this order, if required.
