Her statement has already been recorded under Section 164 of the Code in connection with Raniganj Police Station Case No.230 of 2023.

The report, as placed by Mr. Chatterjee, is taken on record.

In view of such sequence of facts, no interference is called for in the writ petition. Consequently, the writ petition stands disposed of.
