Mr. Arijit Ganguly, Learned Advocate for the State, has submitted a report. The report reflects that Supplementary Charge-sheet was submitted before the Id. Jurisdictional court along with the chemical examiner's report. The same was submitted on or about 10th of November, 2022.

Having regard to the grievance of the petitioner regarding non-supply of the chemical examiner's report, I am of the opinion that the grievance so expressed by the petitioner in the present revisional application, has been served. As such pendency of the present revisional application is unwarranted.
