The petitioners complain of several illegalities which took place on the day of the election and also at the time of counting.

It appears that the complaint was lodged before the respondent authorities on 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2023. The election was conducted on 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 and the result of the election was declared on 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2023.

It appears that the petitioners lodged complaint at a very belated date.

No direction can be passed in the present writ petition for consideration of such complaint which was filed long after the result of the election was declared.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition fails and is hereby dismissed.

It will be open for the petitioners to approach the appropriate forum, if permissible in law, for redressal of their grievances.
