Nobody appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Mr. Banerjee, learned advocate for the opposite party no. 2 submits that the instant revisional application has become infructuous as the petitioner in the instant case has been discharged by the learned court below. He further submits that another revisional application is pending against the order of discharge of the petitioner. He also filed the order of discharge along with the supplementary affidavit on earlier occasion.

Considering the submission and upon perusal of the supplementary affidavit, it appears that the petitioner has been discharged from the proceeding being Case No. CS/0015817/2015 under Sections 465, 466, 467, 469, 471 and 120B of the IPC pending before the learned Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Calcutta.

Accordingly, the revisional application being CRR 2573 of 2016 is dismissed as infructuous.
