1. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
2. The petitioner is the husband of the informant.
3. It is fairly submitted at the Bar that injury suffered by the victim/wife is simple in nature.
4. Regard being had to the facts and submission, factum of permanent residence of the petitioner, nature of allegation, the fact that there is always hope of compromise in matrimonial disputes and such compromise is always in the interest of the family and society, nature of injury as discussed (supra) and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that the petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of his arrest by the Arresting Officer in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
5. The petitioner is directed to appear before the I.O. within 21 days from today along with a server copy or certified copy of

this order.

6. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
7. The application being **CRM (A) 3187 of 2023** is disposed of.
