1. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
2. The petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law respectively of the deceased, who admittedly has committed suicide.
3. From the statement of the witnesses recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C., we find that there is omnibus allegation of additional demand of dowry against the petitioners.
4. Regard being had to the facts and submission, factum of permanent residence of the petitioners, nature of allegation and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that each of the petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of their arrest by the Arresting Officer in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
5. The petitioners are directed to appear before the I.O. within

21 days from today along with a server copy or certified copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
7. The application being **CRM (A) 3253 of 2023** is disposed of.
8. The I.O. is hereby directed to act upon the server copy of this order, if required.
