The learned advocates for both the parties are present.

The learned advocate for the petitioner submits a settlement between the parties to have been achieved on the basis of the memorandum of settlement which has been a part of the decree of divorce granted by the 1st Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Bangalore. The marriage between the parties which had been solemnised on 23.01.2007 and registered on 24.10.2007 was dissolved. The memorandum of settlement as stated above in Paragraph 4 stipulates as follows:

“4. The parties have agreed that the following matters filed by them against each other are pending before the various courts at Kolkata and Bangalore. The parties agree to withdraw/get quashed/disposed off by the respective parties as mentioned below.
