1. It transpires from the affidavit-in-opposition filed by the alleged contemnor no. 1 that on-line application filed by the petitioner is deficient on several scores.
2. Apart from no occupancy proof having been given by the petitioner in his own name, certain portions of the application have been kept blank. That apart, it is contended that due to the locality being covered by water, the connection could not be given to the petitioner.
