1. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
2. It is fairly submitted at the Bar that the present case is a dispute between two partners over siphoning of an amount of Rs. 27 lakhs and odd by the present petitioner, who is admittedly a partner.
3. Regard being had to the facts and submission, factum of permanent residence of the petitioner, nature of allegation and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that the petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of his arrest by the Arresting Officer in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case including the condition that:
 - i) the petitioner is directed to appear before the I.O. once in a fortnight on the day and time fixed by the I.O. for the purpose of investigation till

submission of F.F.

4. The petitioner is directed to appear before the I.O. within 21 days from today along with a server copy or certified copy of this order.
5. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
6. The application being **CRM (A) 3350 of 2023** is disposed of.
7. The I.O. is hereby directed to act upon the server copy of this order, if required.
