1. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
2. The present petitioners are stated to be the parents of the principal accused with whom the victim lady who is also married eloped on her own volition (as found from her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C.).

Regard being had to the facts and submission, factum of permanent residence of the petitioners, nature of allegation and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that each of the petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of their arrest by the Arresting Officer in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
4. The petitioners are directed to appear before the I.O. within 21 days from today along with a server copy or certified copy of this order.
5. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
