The petitioners are the plaintiffs in Title Suit No.1966 of 2019, which is pending before the learned Judge, 12th Bench, City Civil Court at Calcutta. It is submitted that the suit is for eviction of trespasser by application of Section 2(g) of the West Bengal Premises Tenancy Act, 1997. It is submitted that the issues have been framed. The petitioners seek expeditious disposal of the title suit.

Under such circumstances, this court is of the view that justice would be subserved, if the learned court below is directed to dispose of the pending suit, on an urgent basis.

This court has not gone into the merits of the suit. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation, enures to the benefit of all the parties. Hence, prior service of this revisional application upon the opposite party, would not be necessary. The prayer is innocuous and very reasonable.

The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court below to dispose of the pending suit within a period of six months from the next date fixed, without granting unnecessary

adjournments to either of the parties and upon granting adequate opportunity to the opposite party to contest the proceedings. The learned court below shall proceed strictly in accordance with law and independently.

Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of this revisional application along with the server copy of this order upon the opposite party.

Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of.

All the parties are directed to act on the basis of the server copy of this order.
