The petitioner submits that the direction passed by this Court in WP No. 19249 (W) of 2018 on October 11, 2018 has not been implemented by the Municipality.

Learned advocate representing the Municipality submits that the matter was decided by the Municipality and the order communicated to the petitioner by way of a registered letter sent through speed post on February 5, 2019. The envelope addressed to the petitioner returned to the Municipality unserved with the endorsement 'insufficient address'.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
