1. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
2. The basis of implication of the present petitioners is stated to be statement of the co-accused.
3. Regard being had to the facts and submission, factum of permanent residence of the petitioners, nature of allegation, nature of evidence and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that each of the petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of their arrest by the Arresting Officer in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case including the condition that:
 - i) the petitioners are directed to appear before the I.O. once in a week on the day and time fixed by the I.O. for the purpose of investigation till submission of F.F.

4. The petitioners are directed to appear before the I.O. within 21 days from today along with a server copy or certified copy of this order.
5. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
6. The application being **CRM (A) 3463 of 2023** is disposed of.
7. The I.O. is hereby directed to act upon the server copy of this order, if required.
