The petitioners are the plaintiffs in Title Suit No.423 of 2011, which is pending before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 1st Court at Barasat, North 24 Parganas. It is submitted that the suit is at the stage of evidence of the DW. The petitioners pray for expeditious disposal of the said suit.

Considering the age of the suit, this court is of the view that justice would be subserved, if the learned court below is directed to dispose of the pending suit, expeditiously.

This court has not gone into the merits of the suit. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation, enures to the benefit of all the parties. Hence, prior service of this revisional application upon the opposite party, would not be necessary. The prayer is innocuous.

The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court below to make an endeavour to proceed with the suit and dispose of the same within a period of six months from the next date fixed, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties and upon

granting adequate opportunity to the parties to contest the proceedings, as per law. The learned court below shall proceed strictly in accordance with law and independently.

Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of this revisional application along with the server copy of this order upon the opposite party.

Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of.

All the parties are directed to act on the basis of the server copy of this order.
