The petitioner prays for expeditious disposal of the Title Suit No.23 of 2021, which is pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Khatra, Bankura. It is submitted that the urgency is the ground of illness of one of the defendants. It is submitted that no interlocutory applications are pending in the suit.

It appears to the court that the suit was referred to mediation. The report of the learned mediator is not before the court. Hence, it is not possible to ascertain whether the mediation was successful or not.

Under such circumstances, this court is of the view that in case the mediation has failed, the suit shall proceed in accordance with law. This court is of the view that justice would be subserved, if the learned court below is directed to dispose of the pending suit, urgently.

This court has not gone into the merits of the suit. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation, enures to the benefit of all the parties. Hence, prior service of this revisional application

upon the opposite parties, would not be necessary.  
The prayer is innocuous.

The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court below to make an endeavour to proceed with the suit and dispose of the same within a period of six months from the next date fixed, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties and upon granting adequate opportunity to the parties to contest the proceedings, as per law. The learned court below shall proceed strictly in accordance with law and independently.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application along with the server copy of this order upon the opposite parties.

Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of.

All the parties are directed to act on the basis of the server copy of this order.
