Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application upon Mr. Arijit Ganguly, learned advocate, who ordinarily appears for the State. His appointment may be regularised by the concerned authorities.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 05.02.2022 and the investigating agency after completion of investigation has already submitted charge-sheet before the jurisdictional court. The prosecution in order to prove its case has relied upon eight witnesses, all of whom belong to government department. It has been informed that the next date has been fixed on 31.08.2023 for consideration of charges.

Having regard to the plight expressed by the present petitioner as the petitioner is in custody for more than 18 months, I am of the opinion that the learned trial court should overcome the stage of consideration of charges on 31.08.2023, if it is not possible on the said date, then within

a fortnight thereafter, the charges should be considered and the stage must be completed.

In case after consideration of charges, the court is of the opinion that it is required to proceed with the trial of the case, then on and from November 2023, the learned trial court will fix a schedule consisting of three dates and fix such schedule once in every 60 days so that trial of the case can be taken to its logical conclusion within a reasonable period of time. No unnecessary adjournment should be granted to either of the parties.

In case any witness is absent on the date so fixed, the learned trial court would communicate with the Superintendent of Police of the concerned district for ensuring the presence of the witnesses.

Learned public prosecutor conducting the case will at the end of the schedule, supply a list of witnesses, who would appear on the next schedule, to the learned court and the learned court would thereafter fix the schedule. Learned public prosecutor would also ensure regarding the production of materials, documents and exhibits on the dates so fixed for examination of the witnesses.

All stakeholders would cooperate with the learned trial court to conclude the trial at the earliest.

With the aforesaid observations, the revisional application being CRR 3012 of 2023 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.
