1. Heard learned Counsel for both the parties.
2. The petitioners are stated to be husband and the mother-in-law of the victim wife who according to the charge has suffered simple injuries.
3. Regard being had to such facts and submissions, factum of permanent residence of the petitioners, nature of allegation, nature of injury as discussed (Supra), the fact that there is always hope of compromise in matrimonial disputes and such compromise is always in the interest of the family and society and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that each of the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Arresting Officer in the event of their arrest in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
4. The concerned Arresting Officer is hereby directed to act upon the server copy of this order.
5. Within 21 days from today each of the petitioner shall appear before the I.O. alongwith a server copy/certified copy of this

order. If server copy is supplied, learned I.O. shall act upon that.

6. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
7. The application being **CRM (A) 3567 of 2023** is disposed of.
