1. Heard learned advocate for the petitioner and learned advocate for the State.
2. It is the case of the petitioner that the aforesaid police station case has been instituted against the present petitioner out of previous grudge and rivalry. It is fairly submitted at the Bar that the injuries of the victim are not grievous.
3. Regard being had to such facts and submissions, factum of permanent residence of the petitioner, nature of allegation, nature of injury as discussed supra and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Arresting Officer in the event of his arrest in the G.R. Case No.3636 of 2023 arising out of the aforesaid P.S. case on such

terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case including the condition:

- i) The petitioner is directed to appear before the IO once in a fortnight on the day and time fixed by the IO for the purpose of investigation till submission of Final Form.
4. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.
5. Within 21 days from today petitioner is directed to appear before the I.O. along with a server copy or certified copy of this order.
6. The applications being CRM(A) 3663 of 2023 is disposed of.
7. The Arresting Officer is hereby directed to act upon the server copy or certified copy of this order.
