Bibek Chaudhuri, J.

This is an application for effecting joint petition for settlement on the ground that the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled. Therefore, the parties want quashing of criminal proceedings being G.R. Case No.630 of 2019 pending before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate at Barasat, North 24-Parganas.

Previously this Court directed the learned Public Prosecutor-in-Charge to submit a report of the Investigating Officer after

ascertaining the fact as to whether the de-facto complainant is voluntarily and willingly applying for settlement of the dispute. The Investigating Officer has recorded the statement of the de-facto complainant wherefrom it is ascertained that the de-facto complainant voluntarily without any threat, coercion and undue influence wants to settle the dispute.

In view of the fact as stated above, joint application for settlement is accepted.

Accordingly, G.R. Case No.630 of 2019 be treated to be quashed.

Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate at Barasat, North 24-Parganas is directed to pass formal order discharging the accused persons in accordance with the above-mentioned case.

The police report be kept with the record.

The joint application for settlement is accordingly disposed of.
