At the time of call no one appears for the petitioner and no accommodation is prayed for.

However, State-respondents are represented by learned advocate.

The matter was adjourned on several occasions previously on prayer being made by the learned advocate representing the petitioner. Court on considering such prayer granted adjournments on different dates in order to enable the learned advocate for the petitioner to obtain instruction as well as to serve notice upon the respondents.

It appears petitioner has lost interest.

The writ petition stands dismissed.

Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
