Report of the learned Registrar (Judicial Service), High Court, Calcutta be kept on record.

Report dated 11.09.2023 submitted by Mr. Aniket Mitra, learned advocate appearing for the State be also kept on record.

The said report reflects that next date fixed for evidence is on 21.12.2023. There are eight witnesses which the prosecution intends to rely upon to prove its case, out of which examination of only one witness is over and the process of examination of rest of the witnesses are in progress. Having regard to the fact that the case was instituted in the year 2016 and the next date is fixed on 21.12.2023, I direct the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Court, Diamond Harbour henceforth to fix at least one date in a month so that trial of the case can be taken to its logical conclusion within a reasonable period of time.

No unnecessary adjournment should be granted to either of the parties.

All stakeholders would cooperate with the learned trial court to conclude the trial at the earliest.

With the aforesaid observations, the revisional application being CRR 3143 of 2023 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.
