1. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
2. The incident as involved in this case is alleged to have occurred on account of a dissention occurred during last panchayat election.
3. From the materials as placed before us, we find that the injury of the victim who is a police personnel is simple in nature.
4. Regard being had to the facts and submission, factum of permanent residence of the petitioners, nature of allegation, nature of injury as discussed supra and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that each of the petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of their arrest by the Arresting Officer in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case including the conditions that:

- i) The petitioners are directed to appear before the I.O. once in a fortnight on the day and time fixed by the I.O. for the purpose of investigation till submission of Final Form.
- 5. Within 21 days from today, petitioners are directed to appear before the I.O. along with a server copy or certified copy of this order.
- 6. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.
- 7. The application being **CRM (A) 3873 of 2023** is disposed of.
- 8. The I.O. is hereby directed to act upon the server copy of this order, if required.
