1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. The petitioner complains that the private respondents are encroaching upon his land and are constructing a boundary wall. He has complained to the Narendrapur Police Station and is aggrieved by inaction thereof.
3. This Court is of the view that the dispute between the petitioner and the private respondents is purely civil in nature and appropriate civil or statutory remedies may be sought by the petitioner.
4. The Narendrapur Police Station shall, however, ensure that there is absolutely no breach of peace in the area.
