A report has been filed by the Chairman of the District Primary School Council, Purba Bardhaman (not Purba Medinipore as was wrongly recorded in the last order dated 06.02.2023).

Such appointment is to be given by four weeks from the date of communication of this order.

With the above observation and direction, this writ application is disposed of.
