2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the private respondent continues to threaten and intimidate the petitioner and interfere with the peaceful possession of his land. He has complained with the Amta Police Station and is aggrieved by inaction thereof.
3. This Court is of the view that the dispute between the petitioner and the private respondent is purely civil in nature and appropriate civil or statutory remedies may be sought by the petitioner.
4. The Amta Police Station shall, however, ensure that there is absolutely no breach of peace in the area.
5. With the aforesaid observations, the instant writ petition shall stand disposed of.
6. There shall be no order as to costs.
