1. Heard learned Counsel for both the parties.
2. It is fairly submitted at the Bar that the present petitioner is similarly circumstanced with one Kajal Dey who has been enlarged on anticipatory bail vide order dated 29.08.2023 as passed in CRM (A) 3270 of 2023 by us.
3. Regard being had to such facts and submissions, factum of permanent residence of the petitioner, nature of allegation, ground of parity and substantial progress in investigation, it is directed that the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Arresting Officer in the event of his arrest in the aforesaid P.S. case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
4. The concerned Arresting Officer is hereby directed to act upon the server copy of this order.
5. Within 21 days from today the petitioner shall appear before the I.O. alongwith a server copy/certified copy of this order. If server copy is supplied, learned I.O. shall act upon that.
6. Accordingly, the prayer for the anticipatory bail is allowed.

7. The application being CRM (A) 3975 of 2023 is disposed of.
