The petitioner is the plaintiff in Misc. Case No.74 of 2023, which is pending before the learned District Judge, North 24 Parganas, Barasat. The said application is for appointment of guardianship of Shri Jyoti Ranjan Roy, who suffers from an irreversible disease and is allegedly not in a position to act on his own behalf. The petitioner prays for expeditious disposal of the misc. case.

Under such circumstances, this court is of the view that justice would be subserved, if the learned court below is directed to dispose of the said pending application, on an urgent basis.

This court has not gone into the merits of the application. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation, enures to the benefit of all the parties. Hence, prior service of this revisional application upon the opposite parties, would not be necessary. The prayer is innocuous and very reasonable.

The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court below to dispose of the pending application within a period of four

months from the next date fixed, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties and upon granting adequate opportunity to the opposite parties to contest the proceedings. The learned court below shall proceed strictly in accordance with law and independently.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application along with the server copy of this order upon the opposite parties.

Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of.

All the parties are directed to act on the basis of the server copy of this order.
