1. Liberty to correct the cause title.
2. Petitioners submit that there was a land dispute. A free fight ensued. They are not the principal accused. Investigation is complete. They pray for anticipatory bail.
3. Learned lawyer for the State produces the case diary.
4. We have considered the materials on record. There was a land dispute. A free fight ensued. Keeping in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioners in the crime and as investigation is complete, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
5. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/-each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

6. Petitioners shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

7. The application being CRM (A) 4085 of 2023 is disposed of.
