The petitioner prays for expeditious disposal of the Title Suit No.67 of 2021 along with all the applications, which is pending before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 1st Court, Barrackpore, North 24 Parganas.

Under such circumstances, this court is of the view that justice would be subserved, if the learned court below is directed to dispose of the said suit as also the applications, on an urgent basis.

This court has neither gone into the merits of the applications nor into the merits of the suit. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation, enures to the benefit of all the parties. Hence, prior service of this revisional application upon the opposite party, would not be necessary. The prayer is innocuous and very reasonable.

The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court below to dispose of the pending applications within a period of four months from the next date fixed, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties and upon granting adequate opportunity to the

opposite party to file written objections, if not already filed, and to contest the proceedings. Upon disposal of the pending applications, the learned court below shall proceed with the suit and dispose of the same within a year. The learned court below shall proceed strictly in accordance with law and independently.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application along with the server copy of this order upon the opposite party.

Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of.

All the parties are directed to act on the basis of the server copy of this order.
