1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Injury does not appear to be life threatening. Incident occurred in the course of domestic quarrel.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
5. Petitioner shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
6. The application being CRM (A) 4140 of 2023 is disposed of.
