The petitioner's prayer before the Jangipur Municipality seeking mutation is pending consideration for a considerable period of time.

None represents the respondents.

As the prayer of the petitioner is pending consideration at the end of the Municipality, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the writ petition pending.

The writ petition is disposed of by directing the Jangipur Municipality to consider the prayer of the petitioner for mutation in accordance with law after giving reasonable opportunity of hearing to all the necessary parties.

A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the parties.

Effort shall be taken to conclude the proceeding at the earliest but positively within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of this order.

Learned advocate for the petitioner is directed to forward photocopy of all documents relating to mutation to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
