In 3rd line of 1st paragraph and 2nd line of 2nd
paragraph of the order dated 6th December, 2024 “
respondent No.3” shall be read as “**appellant No.3**”.

In 4th paragraph and 5th paragraph of the order
dated 6th December, 2024 “The **informal paper book to
be filed by the concerned parties on the next date of
hearing. Let the matter be fixed on 7th March, 2025**”
this portion should be deleted.

In 3rd paragraph of the order dated 6th
December, 2024 is modified to the following extent
