The instant criminal revisional application has been filed against an order dated 03.11.2011 passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sreerampur in Misc. Case No. 25 of 2008 under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and order dated 23.09.2011 passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sreerampur, Hooghly in M. Ex. Case No. 4 of 2010 arising the Misc. Case No. 25 of 2010 under Section 125 Cr. P.C.
