1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record including the nature of injury. Whether the injuries are life threatening may be assessed during trial. Petitioner is in custody for 159 days. Investigation is complete. There is no chance of abscondence.
3. Hence, we are inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.
4. Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Sukumar Baskey** shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hooghly at Chinsurah subject to condition that he shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

5. In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

7. This application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
