1. Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today be taken on record.
2. The petitioner is aggrieved by notices issued by the CBI and submits that he is being consistently harassed.
3. Central Bureau of Investigation is represented by Mr. Bhattacharyya, learned DSGI. It is submitted that CBI Case No. RC/1/S/2020-EO-6 has been registered by the CBI at Ranchi pursuant to the orders of Jharkhand High Court passed in a Public Interest Litigation.
