2. Likewise on the complaint of the private respondent, the Police have registered FIR No. 98 of 2020 dated 6th August, 2020. Investigation has been completed and the Charge Sheet No. 86 of 2020 under Sections 498A/506/34 of the IPC has been filed.

3. The private respondent/wife is represented and submits that she has no objection to the petitioner returning to the house.

4. The petitioner may return to his house.
5. Instructions of the Madhabdihi Police Station dated 01.12.2022 is taken on record.
6. The writ petition is disposed of.
7. There will be no order as to costs.
