1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Co-accused have been granted pre-arrest bail. Petitioner stands on the same footing and is entitled to same relief.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
