Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of the revisional application upon Mr. Imran Ali, learned advocate, who ordinarily appears on behalf of the State. His appearance may be regularised by the concerned authorities.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in custody for two years and eleven months, although charge has been framed long ago, out of the seventeen witnesses so relied upon by the prosecution, only six witnesses till date have been examined.

Having considered the same, I am of the view that the anxiety expressed by the petitioners is justified. Accordingly, learned trial court is directed to fix a schedule of three dates and fix such schedule on each and every month so that the trial of the case can be taken to its logical conclusion within a very reasonable period of time.

No unnecessary adjournment should be granted to either

of the parties. In case any witness is not cooperating with the learned trial court and is reluctant to appear, learned special court would be at liberty to communicate with the Superintendent of Police of the concerned district who would take steps for ensuring the presence of the witnesses. The public prosecutor conducting the case would ensure regarding the production of the materials, exhibits and documents available on the dates so fixed for examination of the witnesses. All stakeholders would co-operate with the learned trial court so that the trial is concluded at the earliest.

With the aforesaid observations, CRR 4487 of 2023 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.
