The petitioner in Matrimonial Suit No.3648 of 2021, which is pending before the learned Additional District Judge, 6th Court, Alipore, South 24 Parganas, prays for expeditious disposal of the said suit. It is submitted that no other applications are pending. The ground of urgency, as made out by the petitioner, is that she desires to pursue her studies abroad and the pendency of the suit would be an impediment. It is further submitted that issues have been framed.

Under such circumstances, this court is of the view that justice would be subserved, if the learned court below is directed to dispose of the said suit, on an urgent basis.

This court has not gone into the merits of the suit. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation, enures to the benefit of all the parties. Hence, prior service of this revisional application upon the opposite party, would not be necessary. The prayer is innocuous and very reasonable.

The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court below to dispose of

the pending suit within a period of six months from the next date fixed, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties and upon granting adequate opportunity to the opposite party to contest the proceedings. The learned court below shall proceed strictly in accordance with law and independently.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application along with the server copy of this order upon the opposite party.

Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of.

All the parties are directed to act on the basis of the server copy of this order.
