**Bibek Chaudhuri, J.**

This is an application for a direction upon the Trial Court for expeditious disposal of NDPS Case No. 24/2020 under Section 20(C) of the NDPS Act pending before the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Judge, Special Court (NDPS Act), Hooghly.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he was arrested on 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 by the Police on the allegation that he was in illegal possession of narcotic substance. Police submitted supplementary charge-sheet against accused on 3<sup>rd</sup> December, 2020. Charge was framed against accused on 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2021. Thereafter, till date the prosecution failed to examine any witness in support of the charge. Learned Trial Judge is directed to examine the charge-

sheeted witnesss as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six months and then come to logical conclusion of the case within one month thereafter.

With the above direction, the instant revision is disposed of.
