Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

The victim is yet to be recovered.

There is a missing diary lodged with regard to the victim on October 9, 2022.

The present police case relates to kidnapping of the victim by the in-laws of the victim.

The husband and the brother-in-law of the victim were granted bail by the jurisdictional Court.

The present petitioners are the in-laws of the victim.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further

condition that the petitioners will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 6073 of 2022 is disposed of.
